



## 2023 EAM Mobility Grants for Young Researchers

The goal of the grant is to provide financial support to young researchers who plan to collaborate with other research groups at other universities. The grant is limited to researchers with no permanent contract (at either master, PhD, or Postdoc level). Since the research period is self-organized, students are expected to check possible research areas of the university they want to apply to and to find the supervisor themselves.

### Prerequisites:

- To be a Masters or PhD student or a Postdoc researcher without a permanent contract
- To be a member of the EAM
- Minimum length of stay: 4 weeks

### Period of research visit:

- The period of the research visit must be between 01.09.2023 and 31.07.2025

### Grant conditions:

- The financial contribution will be awarded as a lump sum of
  - EUR 1 500 for one month
- Application documents:
  - Application Form (project summary, duration, host university, signature of supervisor, no other travel grants, etc.) (see annex 1 below)
  - A one page Curriculum Vitae and a list of contributions, if any
  - Letter of Acceptance (by an academic supervisor/coordinator at the host institution)

### Application process and deadline:

- Deadline: 30.06.2023

### Selection Process:

- Two grants will be awarded based on
  - Quality of the proposal
  - Fit between the research project and the expertise of the host research group
  - Suitability/appropriateness and quality (CV-basis) of the candidate
- An assessment committee will assess the candidates based on the above-mentioned criteria. Based on the quality of the applications, the grants may be declared void by the assessment committee.

### Selection results:

- All applicants will be informed about the selection results by 31.07.2023.

**Payment:**

- 60% of the grant will be paid a maximum of two-weeks before the starting date of the visit to the Host Institution (candidate should email copy of electronic transportation tickets prior to departure) and the remaining 40% will be paid once the final report (1-2 pages), signed by the Director of the Host Research group, is delivered. This report will be presented within 15 days after the conclusion of the research stay.

**Acknowledgement:**

- The results of the study derived from the grant will be published or presented at a congress, with acknowledgment to the EAM.
