



2024 EAM Mobility Grants for Young Researchers

The goal of the grant is to provide financial support to young researchers who plan to collaborate with other research groups at other universities. The grant is limited to researchers with no permanent contract (at either master, PhD, or Postdoc level). Since the research period is self-organized, applicants are expected to check possible research areas of the university they want to apply to and to find the supervisor themselves.

Prerequisites:

- To be a Masters or PhD student or a Postdoc researcher without a permanent contract
- To be a member of the EAM
- Minimum length of stay: 4 weeks (support offered up to 12 weeks)

Period of research visit:

- The period of the research visit must be between 01.01.2025 and 31.12.2025

Financial conditions:

- For one month research stays, the financial contribution will be awarded as a lump sum of
 - 1500 € per month
- For second and third months (in longer research stays)
 - 1000 € per month*

* If the recipient of the grant does not stay a full additional month (from the second month onwards), the financial contribution will be adjusted on a pro-rata basis according to the number of weeks completed.

Application documents:

- Application Form (project summary, duration, host university, signature of supervisor, no other travel grants for the same stay, etc.) (see annex 1)
- A one-page Curriculum Vitae and a list of contributions, if any
- Letter of Acceptance (by an academic supervisor/coordinator at the host institution)

Application process and deadline:

- Send an email with the application documents to the EAM secretary: Georgina Guilera (gguilera@ub.edu)
- Deadline: 30.11.2024

Selection Process:

- One grant** will be awarded based on
 - Quality of the proposal
 - Fit between the research project and the expertise of the host research group

- Suitability/appropriateness and quality (CV-basis) of the candidate
- An assessment committee will assess the candidates based on the above-mentioned criteria. Based on the quality of the applications, the grants may be declared void by the assessment committee.

** The number of grants awarded may be adjusted based on the duration of the research stay of the highest-ranked applicant, to also support the next one in the ranking.

Selection results:

- All applicants will be informed about the selection results by 15.12.2024.

Payment:

- 60% of the grant will be paid a maximum of two weeks before the starting date of the visit to the Host Institution (candidate should email a copy of transportation or electronic transportation tickets prior to departure) and the remaining 40% will be paid once the final report (1-2 pages), signed by the Director of the Host Research group, is delivered. This report will be presented within 15 days after the conclusion of the research stay. The return ticket will be presented with the report.

Acknowledgement:

- The results of the study derived from the grant will be published or presented at a congress, with acknowledgment to the EAM.
